Statutory Auditors' Report on the Share Capital Decrease

Combined Shareholders' Meeting of 3 June 2026 – 20th Resolution

This is a free translation into English of the Statutory Auditors' report issued in French and is provided solely for the convenience of English-speaking readers. This report should be read in conjunction and construed in accordance with French law and professional auditing standards applicable in France.

To the DBV Technologies Shareholders' Meeting,

In our capacity as statutory auditors of your Company and pursuant to Article L.22-10-62 of the French Commercial Code, in the event of a share capital decrease by cancellation of repurchased shares, we hereby report to you on our assessment of the reasons for, and the terms and conditions of, the proposed decrease in share capital.

Your Board of Directors is asking you to delegate to it, for a period of 18 months from the date of this Meeting, full authority to cancel, on one or more occasions, for up to a maximum of 10% of the share capital per 24-month period, the shares repurchased by your Company pursuant to the implementation of an authorization for your Company to acquire its own shares under the provisions of the aforementioned article.

We performed the procedures we considered necessary in accordance with the professional guidelines issued by the French National Institute of Statutory Auditors (Compagnie Nationale des Commissaires aux Comptes) for this engagement. These procedures consisted in verifying the fairness of the reasons for, and the terms and conditions of, the proposed decrease in share capital, which does not undermine shareholder equality.

We have no observations to make on the reasons for, and the terms and conditions of, the proposed decrease in share capital.
